

## ANNUAL REPORT 2009 – 2010

### HIGHLIGHTS

The Canadian Home Economics Foundation marked its thirtieth year of operation in 2009-2010. The Foundation continues to operate with volunteers and no paid staff. The Executive Committee of the Foundation, based in Winnipeg, held six (6) meetings during the 2009-2010 fiscal year, ending April 30.

The 29<sup>th</sup> Board of Trustees meeting and the Annual Meeting and Donor Recognition were held in Moose Jaw, Saskatchewan in conjunction with the Association of Saskatchewan Home Economists / Saskatchewan Home Economics Teachers Association Conference in the fall of 2009.

Funding of \$31,514 was approved for twenty grants and awards in the areas of research, education, public service and post-secondary education and training. Provincial Trustees have chaired Awards committees and distributed information about the Foundation to local meetings and conferences.

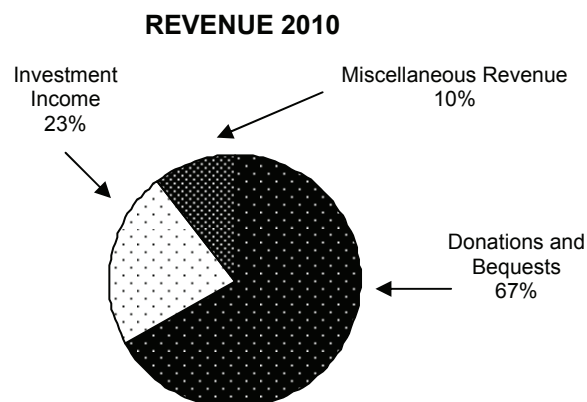

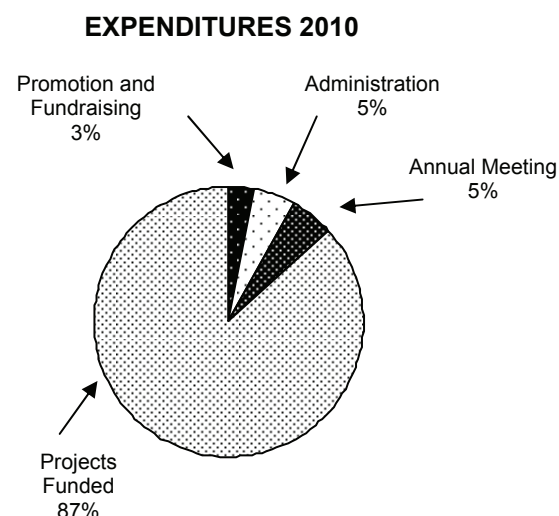
