

## ANNUAL REPORT 2007 – 2008

### HIGHLIGHTS

The Executive Committee of the Foundation held nine (9) meetings during 2007-2008, as well as the Board of Trustees Annual Meeting and the Foundation's 27<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting and Donor Recognition held during the Manitoba Home Economics Association Conference held in Portage La Prairie in the fall, 2007.

The Board experienced many trustee changes this year. Dr. Ruth Berry (Projects) left the Executive in 2007; Nancy Schneider was welcomed to succeed her. Kathryn Baranovsky (Communications) left the Executive in 2007 after serving twenty-three (23) years; Tracey Drabyk-Zirk was welcomed to take over Communications. Stephanie Charron, ON and Glenda Molgat, AB resigned from the Board after serving several years. Joining the Board as provincial representatives are: Ann-Marie Steenge, BC, Murielle Gaudet, NB, Marie Slusar, AB, Ellen Boynton, ON (Ottawa area).

During the past year funding was approved for 26 grants and awards to a total level of \$31,017. Informa-

tion about the new focus of the Gwenyth Bailey Simpson Communications Award was distributed in February with two projects approved in April. For the 2007-2008 year awards were granted from all of the funding categories (designated funds) as well as from general funds.

A local Winnipeg web designer was hired to redevelop the Foundation website, with a launch date in the fall of 2008.

Foundation information was provided to meetings of the Canadian Association for Research in Home Economics, the Association of Canadian Human Ecology Students, several university alumni reunions and home economics and home economics / family studies teachers associations.

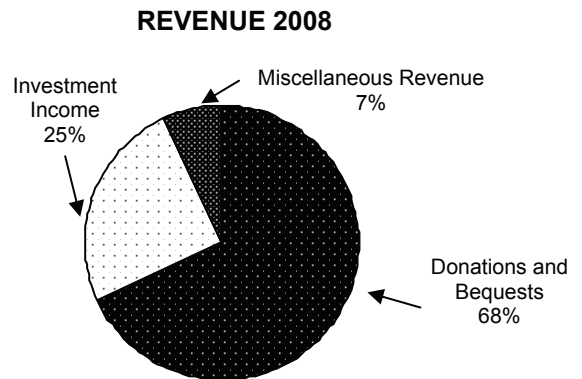

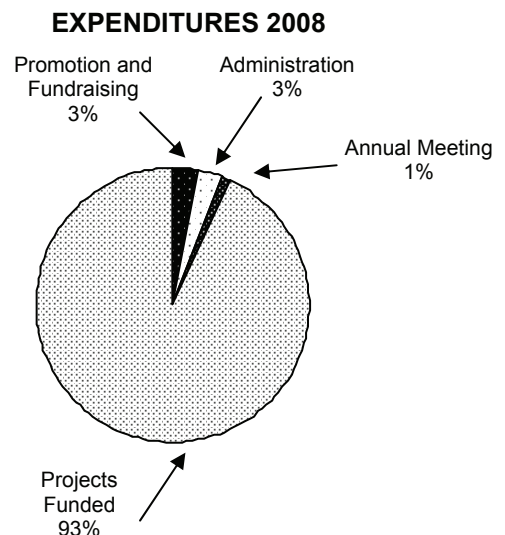
